Schedule occupation therapy 5-7 days post-op

Time Frame	Treatment	Goals
Post-Op Day: 5-7 days	 Evaluate and Treat Remove dressing Educate in home care for incision and dressing change If skin graft is present leave stint intact and do not soak to remove dressing Custom fabricate hand based extension orthosis Educate on wear and care instructions Precaution if skin graft is present fabricate non-tension ext orthosis, gradually progress ext each week Assess AROM Instruct on HEP Gentle AROM; tendon glide, joint blocking Progress with AAROM and PROM as tolerated Follow up is typically 1x/week depending on motion If McCash technique (open incision in palm) educate on wet to dry dressing change 	 Edema management HEP ROM Scar management Skin graft protection
Phase I: 2 weeks post-op	 Readjust orthosis into further extension as tolerated Instruct in scar management techniques if sutures are removed Continue with HEP AROM, PROM and AAROM to tolerance 	 ROM Scar management Edema Management
Phase II : 3 weeks post-op	 May use modalities as indicated Typically not started until 4 weeks post-op May include Ketoprofen, Dexamethasone, or Potassium lodide as indicated. Readjust orthosis PRN Continue with HEP 	 Scar management ROM

Phase III:	 Discontinue night time orthosis when determined by physician
3-6 months post-	
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
