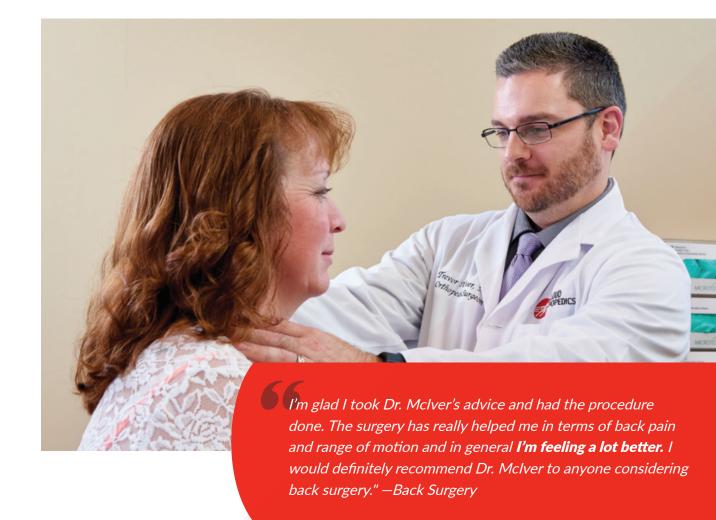

TECHNOLOGY HIGHLIGHTS

Part of our clinic's ongoing mission is to bring our patients the very best proven technology. If they've been clinically shown to reduce the invasiveness of a procedure, increase precision, and reduce recovery time to get you back on your feet faster, our team is among the first to bring those options back here to you—without passing along the cost. Here are some of our more recent offerings and how they work.

My surgery was performed by Dr. Hwang and he made it clear he was always available. He told me to call anytime and was very open to answering all my questions. GaitScan

The use of GAIT (Gait Analysis Interval Testing) lets us review your natural step pattern and detect any arch-related issues in your feet and lower extremities. From the data we gather in this fast test, we can create custom orthotics to help relieve foot pain, while our physical therapists can work with you to correct the situation further.

AlterG Anti-Gravity Treadmill

The AlterG Anti-Gravity Treadmill was originally developed using NASA-based technology. It works by supporting up to 80% of the user's weight during walking or running, thereby reducing stress and impact on the body. This results in pain-free, comfortable motion during physical therapy following an injury or a procedure. This piece of equipment can be used in our clinic to get you up and moving again faster than traditional recovery methods.

Robotics-Assisted Surgery

With robotics, the skill of the surgeon is still in control, but assisted by the navigation of the technology. This allows for improved reproducibility, accuracy, precision, and safety. Because of its tissuesparing benefits, these types of surgical procedures are becoming more and more outpatient based, allowing you the ability to literally walk out the door and go home that same day—if this technique matches your needs.

OrthoDirect cares for all common, yet urgent, orthopedic-related injuries:

- Broken or fractured bones
- Athletic and sports-related injuries
- Sprains, strains and other soft tissue injuries
- Torn ligaments
- Dislocated joints

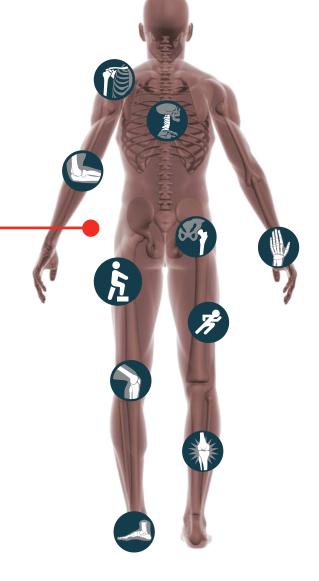

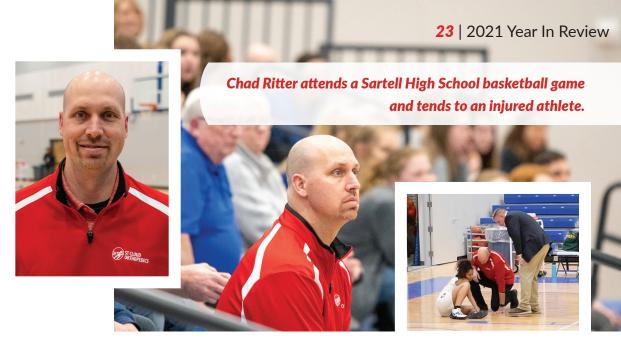


Athletic Training

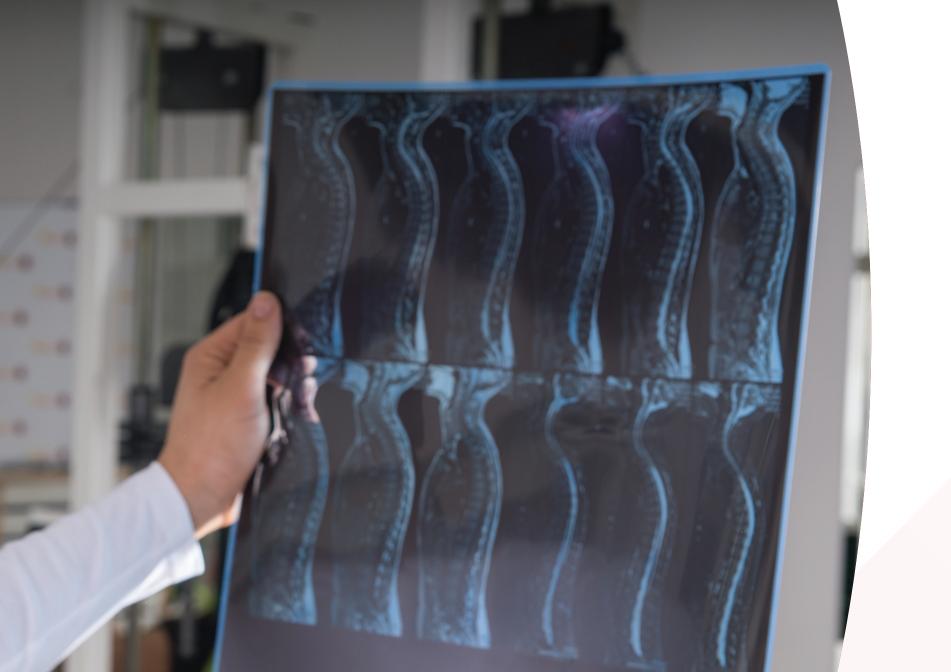

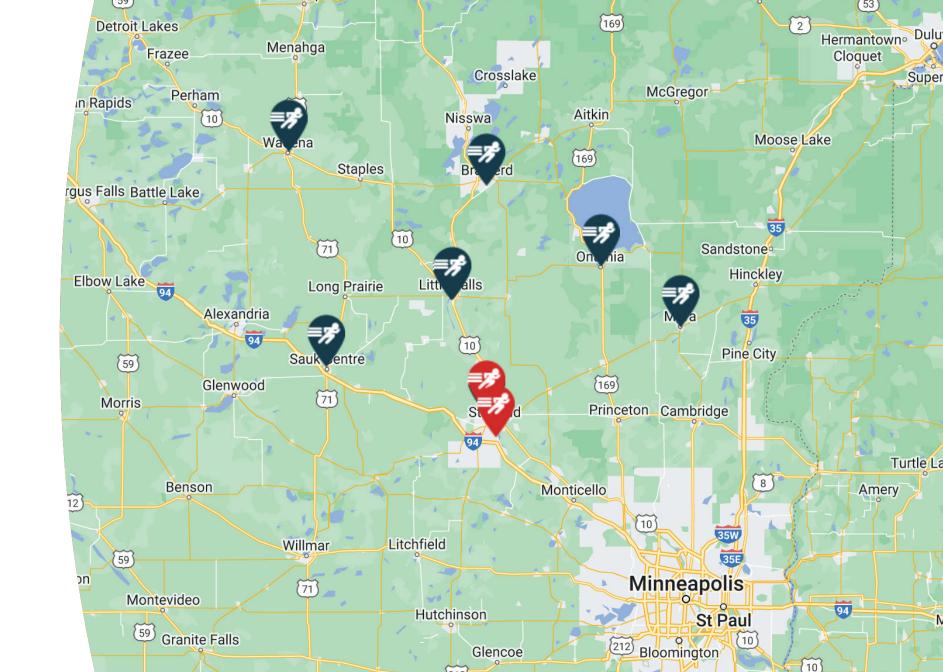
MAP

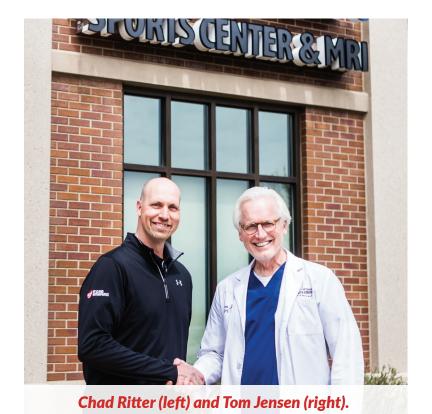

Chad Ritter: New Director/Supervisor of Rehabilitation Services

Chad has been with St. Cloud Orthopedics for 18 years, since 2003, working as both a Physical Therapist and a Certified Athletic Trainer for all of Sports Medicine, including injuries of the knee, hip, ankle, shoulder, and spine.

When longtime Director Tom Jensen (TJ) announced his retirement after more than 40 years this spring, Chad applied for the position, which was opened both internally and externally. Accepting the position is a career highlight for him. TJ and Chad go way back.
